You Bring

Our in-take coordinator will meet with you to determine if the program is right for you and if you are eligible.

- You must be an internationally-licensed medical doctor or international health professional
- You must demonstrate English language competency
- You bring a positive and flexible attitude along with a sincere desire to move forward
- You are available to attend and participate in all workshops and fulfill workshop tasks

We Provide

During the month-long series of workshops you will receive 35 hours of instruction and learn:

- How to adapt to Canadian workplace culture
- How to identify your transferable skills
- How to job search and identify employment opportunities
- How to write effective résumés and cover letters and
- How to market yourself while networking, in interviews and in social media
- How to succeed in job interviews

Once you complete the program you will continue to receive on-going support and job development including:

- Weekly emails with the latest job postings, volunteer opportunities and networking and learning events
- Ongoing support with résumés, cover letters and applications
- Special opportunities based on your specific talents and skills from employers and community partners
