HOW CCI IS ORGANIZED

YOUR FIRST VISIT

All clients must check in at Reception. New clients will register and meet an intake counsellor to discuss your needs. If a follow-up visit is needed, you will be assigned a counsellor. All future visits will be appointment only.

CURRENT CLIENTS

Newcomers who are already clients still need to check in with the Reception Desk on the main floor. If you have an appointment, your counsellor will be contacted and will meet you in Reception. An appointment guarantees you will get to visit your counsellor. Counsellors work out of the office 50 per cent of the time, so that's why you need to make an appointment.
